There is a consultation regarding the Pylons to be installed in the Duddon Valley. That ends this Friday so any responses must be made prior to that date.

971 BROUGHTON BECK PHONE BOX

Brian Campbell will check with Sheila Saunders about the phone that is to be installed.

Howard Graves has gathered expenses that need compensating from the Council regarding the phone box restoration.
