### 1519: Items for discussion/Report on progress

- a) Parking spaces on Parish Land at the rear of The Thimbles- advertisement to be displayed on notice boards and papers for application to be sent to the existing tenants.
- b) Spark Bridge Allotments completed purchase 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023. Letters have been sent out to five of the six allotment holders.
  - The council agreed to serve notice on the allotment holder (who no longer tends the allotment) in accordance with the agreement and give one months' notice.

    There is a waiting list of interested parties and the rent for a new holder would be 30p per square metre, which is in accordance with other local allotment charges.
- c) Highways Report on progress- Nothing further to report other than to contact Westmorland & Furness Councillor, Ben Cooper to see if a representative from Highways could attend future meetings.
- d) Local flooding. Issues of potential flooding at Greenodd, chased Environment agency 9<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

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- e) Resilience Plan Report on progress / use of Greenodd Village Hall in an emergency. Grants are available for funding of ie electric charging points through ENW Fund. Cllr. Hartley is in contact with Greenodd Village Hall which could be used as a Hub. Clerk to contact Cllr. Hartley and review in July 2023 meeting.
- f) Schools Volunteer Project for Sedbergh school working days June. Suggestions of projects within the Parish.
  - Catherine Bettney reported that 10 students from Sedbergh School would be volunteering their services on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June and Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June. She has had a site meeting with Cllr. Hartley over potential projects within the Parish eg painting of Bus Shelter at Greenodd,
- g) Rosside Trees at Tarn Close report on progress. Chair reported that tree survey is likely to be undertaken now the trees are in full leaf- review in July 2023 meeting.
- h) General Parishioners comments- concerns of speed of traffic on A590 especially through Penny Bridge during school times. Suggestions of traffic calming measures eg 20 is plenty signs

The issue is not on the A590 but on A5092 and also by the school. This is an ongoing problem and needs to be reported to the new authority.
