

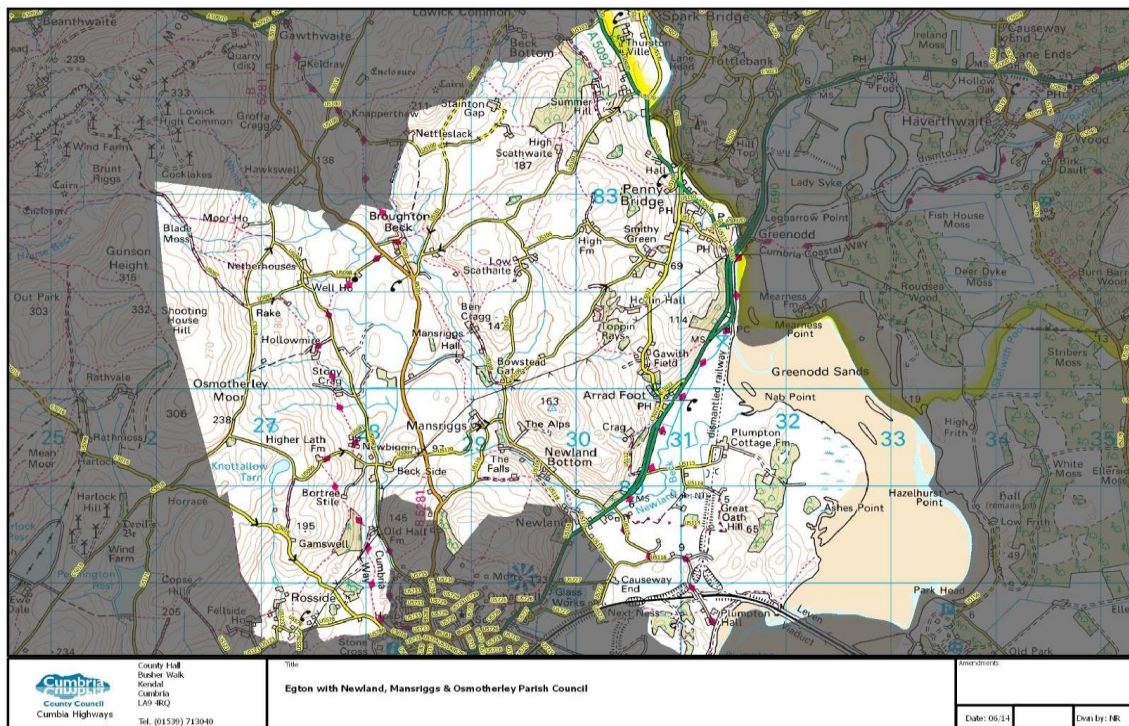

ENMO Parish Council is underway with a heritage project. We would like to invite people living in the area to collaborate in the production of written, oral, and visual records capturing their unique historical past. The records will be gathered either by research in Barrow library archives etc., or by interviewing residents. The records could be written text, hardcopy photographs, maps, etc. and will be displayed on the ENMO internet site. People involved will be divided into two groups, one who will carry out the research and the other who will carry out the interviews. Another smaller group will convert the text, photos etc., using software, so that it can be placed on the internet site. All people taking part will receive training but it would be very helpful if anyone has existing relevant skills.
