1708: Co-option of a new Parish Councillors Osmotherley ward– resolved to re advertise vacancy

Appoint new trustee for Egton Parish Lands Trust

Appointment of Trustees to Egton Parish Lands Trust- Motion passed ‘in accordance with the terms of the Sealed Charity Commission Scheme of 10th May 1991 for the Egton Parish Lands Trust, the Council appoints Mary Green as a Nominated Trustee created by the resignation Geoffrey Moore. Proposed by Cllr. Edmondson and seconded by Cllr. Hartley

1709: Precept. To agree precept 2026/27 – Budget forecast as circulated in advance of this meeting - Resolved the Councillors voted to increase the precept by 2% to £8,200. The Council approved this and was proposed by Cllr. Hartley and seconded by Cllr. Green

Therefore, it was resolved that at the meeting held 13th January 2026 to request the sum of £8,200 (eight thousand, two hundred pounds) from the Council Tax of the Parish to meet the expenses of the Parish Council/ meeting.

- e) **Flooding issues in Greenodd in December 2025** – Silver Lane This was reported after heavy rain in the area
- f) **Wall at Tarn Close**- letter sent to the Bensons advising on the Parish Council’s position
- g) **Bus Shelter at Penny Bridge**- Cllr. Campbell reported that he had spoken to an architect who suggested that a repair might be more cost effect rather than demolish the old bus stop. Councillors raised their concerns in that priority was that people could see within
